## Abstract

## THE SONG

Song, according to Doren in Andianto (2010), is a brief musical piece set to a poetic text, with equal emphasis on the music and the lyrics. It's usually played with instrumental accompaniment and might be written for one or more singers. Besides, Redlich in Andianto (2010) stated that a song is a short composition usually for one voice based on lyrics or poetry. The lyrics and text are very diverse, they can be simple songs or long songs; then in in the form of a sentence or just a word, even syllables and songs are usually combined with music.

Meanwhile, Griffe (1995) in Septiani (2010) argues that songs are in the form of pieces music that has words. From this statement, we can conclude that the song is a combination of words to other words into short pieces.

## THE VALUE OF SONGS

One of the methods that can support the process of learning vocabulary is a. Shaleha Isnaini and Dyah Aminatun (2021) mention that songs can be an effective learning method, they stated that songs can be an effective method for teaching English, introducing new English terms and expanding their vocabulary. As we also know, nowadays many students like to listen to songs, the more songs they listen to, the more new vocabulary they will acquire. As stated by Dale (1992: 5) that songs are good in introducing vocabulary because songs provide a meaningful context for vocabulary. Media provides a fun situation for students. Furthermore, using songs in learning English will increase students' interest in learning because it is more interesting and fun. As Paul (2003:58) states, that songs can provide feeling and rhythm to language practice that might otherwise be boring, making it easier for students to remember things and bringing students deeper into a lesson. According to Eva Faliyanti (2020) Almost everyone loves songs and also easy to help find it. Everyone can listen to a song at anytime and anywhere. Because there is more variety in song, students are not bored. According to him, listen a song helps memorizing vocabulary easier than any other way.

In research conducted by Yunita Gasma, HeryYufrizal, Muhammad Sukirlan (2020) showed that there is a significant increase in the increase in students' vocabulary achievement after they are taught using songs, they can remember vocabulary easily and feel comfortable during the learning process. in another study conducted by Shaleha Isnaini and Dyah Aminatun (2021) showed that the students feel that English songs are interesting and entertaining as the media for them to learn new

vocabulary, unfamiliar vocabulary, and pronounce the word correctly. The end, songs also can improve their vocabulary.

According to Paul (2003:57), there are several ways to employ English songs in the classroom: 1) Singing, 2) Actions, 3) Chants, 4) Background Songs, and 5) in the times between lessons English songs can be used in classrooms to help students learn English. When teaching learning activities, there are many ways to employ songs or English songs, such as using While the kids are learning the lessons, music is played in the background.
